


Proposed 2023 Amendments

- As a living document, the Plan will be reviewed annually during this Council's elected term to ensure it continues to capture the priorities of Council.










- The first annual review took place at the February 2023 Retreat where Council and Administration discussed proposed amendments and priorities.
- Based on the feedback provided by Council, the following amendments are recommended by Administration.








Combining 3.c.1 and 3.c.2

- Goal 3: Parks and recreation facilities are designed to achieve multiple benefits and accommodate a diversity of people and activities.
- Objective c: Invest in infrastructure to support recreation programming.

Combining 3.c.1 and 3.c.2

- Action 3.c.1: Review the City's approved Outdoor Facilities Strategy and implement the recommendations that best serve the needs of the community.
- Action 3.c.2: Review the City's approved Indoor Facilities Strategy and implement the recommendations that best serve the needs of the community.



 Action 3.c.1: Conduct a recreation facility review that identifies strategies and actions that best address community recreation needs.





Reprioritizing 4.a.5

- Goal 4: Collaborative, creative, and innovative approaches and tools are used to leverage culture resources to enhance quality of life.
- **Objective a:** Leverage existing infrastructure spaces to incorporate culture experiences and artifacts.
- Action 5: Develop a new Public Art Policy.

Adding 5.a.3

- **Goal 5:** Urban agriculture is leveraged to develop more opportunities for residents to interact with the environment.
- Objective a: Develop an urban agriculture strategy that balances land use opportunities with policy requirements.
- Action 3 (net new): Develop Urban Agriculture Master Plan.
- Prioritized for 2024



Change in Scope for Wayfinding Action

- **Goal 11:** Our City Centre is a vibrant hub for culture, commerce, and civic life.
- Objective a: Create opportunities for residents to experience a revitalized City Centre.
- Action 4: Create a program that recognizes and marks points of interest and wayfinding signs within the City Centre.

- **Goal 6:** Safe, livable, and sustainable neighbourhoods for all residents that contribute to a high quality of life.
- Objective a: Plan for neighbourhoods that offer a range of housing options, employment opportunities, art, culture and recreation facilities, and other amenities as part of the Municipal Development Plan (MDP) update.
- Action 4: Create a wayfinding program that leverages the new branding strategy and guides residents and visitors to points of interest and amenities within the City.
