

Purpose



- This Bylaw:
 - provides regulations to guide development, and
 - >> it conforms with the City Centre Area Redevelopment Plan.
- >> A Summary Report is provided to Council in this meetings agenda package that reviewed topics raised at the Bylaw's first public hearing.
- Administration has provided possible alternative regulations that Council may consider as amendments to the current Bylaw.





New Considerations



- Items reviewed at the Public Hearing included:
 - Commercial Parking Standards,
 - Parking Facility Standards,
 - Approach to City Centre Residential Density, and
 - Meridian Housing Foundation redistricting to R2CC District.





Proposed Amendments



Recommended Amendments

- >> Reduce on-site parking standard from 1/55 m² to 1/85m².
- >> Reduce R2CC District density from 140 uprha to 130 uprha.

> Housekeeping - Updates

- Adjust for recent Awning and Canopy definition changes.
- >> Add C1 District regulations clarifying how Parking Facilities may front streets as defined in the City Centre Area Redevelopment Plan.

Storefront Improvement Program

- Adjust to exempt Development Permit requirement for some conforming non-structural alterations; and,
- Add minor variances for storefront improvements to nonconforming buildings.
