TITLE - FIRE HYDRANTS FOR PRIVATE DEVELOPMENT

## POLICY STATEMENT \*

The Town of Spruce Grove will flush and service the fire hydrants along with their own program, however, hydrants found defective must be immediately repaired by the owner of the development at his own expense.

No persons other than authorized employees of the Town shall open or close or operate or interfere with any valve, hydrant or fire plug, or draw water therefrom, as per By-law No. 556.

The Chief of the Town Fire Department, his assistants and officers, and members of that Department, are authorized to use the hydrants or plugs for the purpose of extinguishing fires, or for making trial of hose pipe, or for fire protection but all such uses shall be under the direction and supervision of the said Chief or his duly authorized assistants, and in no event shall any inexperienced or incompetent person be permitted to manipulate or control in any way, any hydrant or plug.
