This engagement report has been broken into three (3) particular sections. Section 1 includes a What We Heard summary from online engagement that occurred during the peak of the COVID-19 pandemic (December 2020 - January 2021). Section 2 includes a second What We Heard summary from a Public Open House held April 13, 2022 at the Pioneer Centre in Spruce Grove. Section 3 includes a What We Did summary based off the feedback provided from both the online engagement and the public open house, and how the feedback was utilized to inform the proposed amendments to-date.

Online Google Forms A summary of returned forms, phone calls, and email inquiries has been produced to capture the essence of the first round of initial online engagement. This initial outreach and feedback engagement ultimately was designed to:

1) create public awareness to the project; 2) facilitate an understanding of what is occurring; 3) collect input that captures a wider range of perspectives; 4) highlight key issues so they may be resolved or incorporated early on in the project's process.

Of the 33 returned surveys 2/3 (66%) of respondents had mailing addresses found within Mobile City Estates. Respondents stated they are largely in support of Area A evolving to a higher standard over time through unit replacement. Concerns stemmed from their future or potential role as it relates to unit replacement or upgrades. Additional feedback indicated they would like to see added visitor parking, sidewalks, and a play space for children within Area A. Area B responses expressed interest in greater rear setbacks from existing Westgrove Residential to the rear of a manufactured home unit as well as tree and fence privacy buffer to separate the two developments. In addition, there was concern over the loss of the ability to connect / walk to the commercial shopping centre located south of Mobile City Estates. Other respondents indicated support for the future development of Area B and view it as an opportunity to further enhancer the greater area through the addition of new manufactured homes. Area C responses indicated a preferred sentiment to keep this area as a natural space with amenities such as trails, benches, and off-leash space.

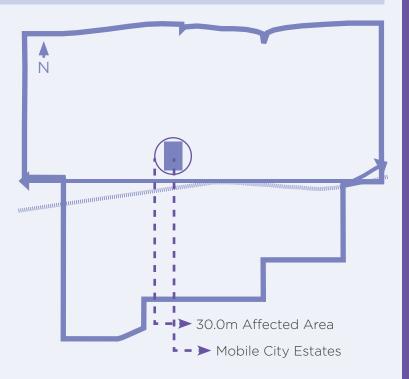
Nearly 30 attendees came out to the Mobile City Estates Public Open House, held April 13 from 6pm-730pm at the Pioneer Centre in Spruce Grove, AB. The evening began with a formal presentation by the project team, followed by a question and answer period from attendees. The purpose of the Open House was: 1) to provide an additional touch point with members of the public on the application and progress made to date; 2) review and answer questions on proposed regulations informed (inpart) by the previous online engagement; 3) ensure a shared understanding of how the text amendments would be applied and answer questions relating to the impact of the proposed regulations on existing tenants and their manufactured home units / yards; and 4) to allow for attendees an additional opportunity to review new information and provide further feedback or commentary on the proposal prior to its finalization and proceeding through the Council adoption process.

attendees at the Open House, a the majority were tenants of Mobile City Estates. Of the six (6) returned and completed feedback forms, all six (6) were completed by tenants of Mobile City Estates. Respondents stated that they are either very familiar or somewhat familiar with the project area and the current land use bylaw application. Respondents amendment through recorded live concerns comments at the Open House or through their formal feedback forms, which are as follows: 1) the interface between existing Area A units backyards and proposed / future Area B unit backyards and how the existing yards may be decreased in size to accommodate future development; 2) not enough visitor parking stalls; 3) would like a dedicated play area for children in the form of a playground or play space; and 4) unit signage and addressing issues.

Incorporation Of Feedback



To conclude, the proposed section 120 RMHC has incorporated feedback provided throughout the application's history and in doing so has resulted in a responsive district that will support landowner aspirations, while also providing current tenants, and affected area residents with development certainties against privacy impacts, and guest parking needs. Moreover, the newly proposed regulations will also provide the City of Spruce Grove with a more predictable site and unit arrangement for increased overall safety and aesthetic.

Through review and analysis of all feedback provided, the proposed text amendments to Section 120 RMHC have endeavored to integrate as much of the feedback provided by respondents. In doing so, this has enabled the newly proposed Section 120 RMHC to be a district that will not only enable the addition of new and affordable manufactured home units, but will also bring the district to a modern standard, while simultaneously ensuring there is greater privacy mitigation and overall orderly unit arrangement across Area A and B of the site.

Through initial engagement (December 13, 2020 - January 13, 2021) a primary point of feedback was how new development in Area B would interact with existing single detached homes within Westgrove residential. What we did in response to this was create a 7.0m rear setback regulation for future units adjacent to Westgrove, while also requiring an additional 1 tree per manufactured home stall to be included within the rear setback to further mitigate privacy concerns. In addition, the requirement of a uniform fence has also been added as a regulation to further ensure Westgrove and Area B of Mobile City are well delineated.

From the feedback provided at the Open House what we have done is required that guest parking be accommodated through a 1 visitor stall for every 7 manufactured homes regulation. Further, we have also required unit addressing to be approved by the City for each new unit placed in the site. As it relates to common amenity space, accessory uses and accessory buildings would enable this opportunity (at the owner's discretion), however this will not be a regulation requirement due to a private amenity space regulation requirement of a minimum of 7.5m2 per manufactured home unit, along with ample open space located at St. Joseph Catholic School (directly adjacent to north part of Area A), as well as the natural recreation opportunities included within the remaining undeveloped Area C.

- Standardize the layout of home units to create a cohesive site area.

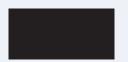
