Environmental Sustainability

- Recommendation to reword action to “Create an Urban Forest Management Plan.”
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- 9.b.5 Review the City’s Natural Areas Management Policy, particularly in regards to storm water management facilities, trail management, and urban forest management.
- Recommendation to reword action to “Develop a storm water facilities management plan.”
