- The City recognizes Land Use Bylaw changes are needed to improve the District's usefulness.






Proposed Text Amendment




- Proposes substantial changes to the existing Manufactured Home Court District
- The existing District is to be rescinded and replaced in its entirety
- The proposed regulation pertains to Mobile City Estates, the district's only user.









Location and Site



- Mobile City Estates is located west of Calahoo Road west of the City Centre
- The site is 22.2 ha with approximately 20% of its lands remaining undeveloped
- The existing development has approximately 240 units
- Current density of 10.8 dwelling units per net residential hectare it is a low-density residential use in the City







Proposed Text Amendment



Area A – Existing Mobile City Estates


addresses the existing development to clarify how it is to be managed over time allowing for orderly and incremental upgrading.

Area B – Expansion Area

Provides a regulatory system for the expansion area

Area C – Future Development

a large, treed site adjacent to Heritage Grove Park will remain as a future development area







Recommendation

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- Administration supports this amendment.
- This proposal provides:
 - a regulatory system that will allow Mobile City Estates development to continue with a higher degree of predictability regarding the site's development outcome and safe operation.
