TOWN OF SPRUCE GROVE

BY-LAW NO. 757-85

BY-LAW TO REQUIRE PASTEURIZATION OF MILK IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 57.1 OF THE DAIRY INDUSTRY ACT

Being a By-Law of the Town of Spruce Grove requiring milk sold, offered for sale or delivered within the limits of said Town of Spruce Grove to be pasteurized before being sold, offered for sale or delivered.

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 57.1 of The Dairy Industry Act that the Council of any municipality may pass a By-Law for the purpose of requiring milk sold, offered for sale or delivered within the limits of the municipality to be pasteurized before being sold, offered for sale or delivered; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Spruce Grove in Council assembled ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- For the purpose of this By-Law, "pasteurization" and "pasteurized" shall have the meaning given to these words in Section 57.1 of The Dairy Industry Act.
- No person shall sell, offer for sale or deliver within the limits of the Town of Spruce Grove milk which has not been pasteurized.
- 3. Section 2 of this By-Law shall not apply to milk brought into the municipality by the producer and sold to a dairy manufacturing plant, or to products of milk manufactured, processed or reprocess or packed or repacked in a dairy manufacturing plant or brought in by an individual for personal use in accordance with the requirement of the Dairy Industry Act and the regulations.
- 4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-Law shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) exclusive of costs, and in default of payment of the fine and costs, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding sixty days.
- This By-Law shall come into force and effect upon the date of its final reading.
