

Good afternoon,

I am not certain I will be able to attend on the 13th., and understand I can submit questions.

I would like an explanation why the surveyor stakes placed at the last survey done [2020] are approximately 1m. or 3.5 ft. closer to my house and now impacting my shed. In 2012 my shed was not impacted. I find this discrepancy frustrating when I am not given a reason.

If this is happening to give more setback to the homes along Westglen and Weston, then perhaps the new lots do not need to be 400sq. meters and above.

I am not opposed to this development. We need more affordable housing and more ground level access for seniors. I have never been opposed to it. I am disappointed at the lack of transparency and honesty. We were told in 2012 to sign consent to have our fence removed or be evicted. I signed. Nothing happened. We were told again in 2020 to sign. I signed and nothing has happened. Each time we were told this was a done deal.

Further to the problem with my shed, I have virtually nowhere to move it. My home sits back farther and the new fence will leave me about 1m. of backyard space. Less than that on half of it because I have raised vegetable garden beds.
