- Consistency in definitions
- Typographical error
- Conduct more research on:
 - Domesticated Pet limit on numbers
 - Domesticated Pet limit on size



- Identification Section modified
- Definition Section addressed
- Section 4.9 addressed



Domesticated Pets Research

- Very few examples where it is permitted
 - Edmonton
 - Leduc
 - Calgary
 - Morinville
- Still very restrictive



Domesticated Pets Research (continued)

- Reasons for restrictions
- Average animal size examples
 - Goats, Pot belly Pigs, Sheep, Mini cows
- No real information around an appropriate numbers limit
- Other Exotic Animals considered



Future Bylaw Exemptions / Changes

- Hens, etc.
- Changes to section 4.1 Exemptions



Recommendation of Administration

- Do not allow for Domesticated Pets
- Revert to original Bylaw Language where needed
- Add the new Exemption Section
- Retain Cat regulations
- Retain new fines
- Retain new Animal Protection section
