## Introduction

Our mission is to offer a secure and nurturing environment where women and children facing domestic violence, homelessness, or other crises can find respite and begin their journey toward stability and independence.



## What is Domestic Violence

Domestic violence refers to a pattern of abusive behaviours used by one partner to gain or maintain control over another partner in an intimate relationship. This abuse can take many forms, including physical violence, emotional or psychological abuse, sexual coercion, and economic control.

## Affected by Homelessness

Single-parent families often experience homelessness due to a lack of affordable housing, unemployment, poverty, and low wages. For women, the most common cause of homelessness is domestic violence, which can leave her and her children on the streets.



## Pregnant And In Crisis

Children born into homelessness face higher risks of low birth weight and developmental health issues due to their mothers' lack of nutritious food, limited access to prenatal care, and potential struggles with drug abuse or mental illness, leading to a difficult start in life.

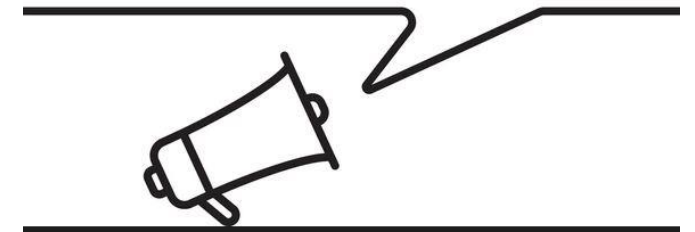
