Action on Smoking & Health (ASH Canada)



ASH Western Policy Project



Alberta pilot funded by Alberta Health Services between 2016 and 2019 Pilot contributed to 50 new gold-standard bylaws and policies in Alberta



Health Canada SUAP Grant 2018/2019: Project scale-up across Western Canada

Launched new 3-year western project in July 2019



Conducted baseline surveys, prepared policy hub and hired project staff in 2019

Began outreach activities in January 2020

Tobacco Quick Facts





- > Compromised quality of life
- > 50,000 annual deaths; 20% of all deaths; 1 million people suffering
- > 1 in 2 smokers will die prematurely
- > Economic cost is **\$15 billion annually**
- > Secondhand smoke kills 1,000 annually; No safe level of exposure
- > Thousands of chemicals; dozens of known carcinogens

Vaping Quick Facts





In 2018/2019, over **400,000 Canadian youth** had vaped in the last 30 days



Youth who vape are at least **3 times more** likely to start smoking tobacco




One adult stops cigarette smoking by vaping for **every 80 youth vapers** who start smoking



Almost **100% of youth** start vaping using flavoured products

Modeling to Youth



Bylaw Provision

Comprehensive smoke-free bylaw: Align cannabis, vaping & smoking

- Reduce social modelling
- Promote healthy communities
- Protect at risk populations
- Simplify enforcement



Smoke-free public events, outdoor spaces and markets

- Reduce social modelling to children and youth
- Protect public health

Bylaw Provision



Smoke-free group living facilities

- Right to breather clean air
- Disproportionately vulnerable population



Smoke-free hotel and motel rooms

- Protection for workers & patrons
- Level the playing field

Bylaw Provision

Smoking and vaping retail licensing

- Alcohol and cannabis retailers are licensed
- Support enforcement; prevent sales to minors



Signage

• Strategic placement that is highly visible



Close the cigar lounge loophole

Bylaw to ban smoking in all workplaces and public establishments without allowances for designated smoking rooms

Amend business license and/or zoning bylaw to prohibit cigar and shisha lounges



ASH Model Smoke-free Bylaw



- Ban smoking/vaping at all outdoor recreation spaces (parks, playgrounds, sports fields, beaches, etc.)
- Smoke-free public events (sport and cultural events, markets, etc.)
- Smoke-free hotels, motels, patios and group living facilities
- Align restrictions on all forms of smoking/vaping (tobacco, nicotine, cannabis, hookah)



ASH Model Smoke-free Bylaw



Create setback distances from patios, doors, windows and air intakes

 No smoking in restaurants or lounges including cigars, shisha and cannabis
