

# **REQUEST FOR DECISION**

**MEETING DATE:** February 28, 2022

TITLE: C-1191-22 Land Use Bylaw Amendment - Redistricting - Ball Park

District Stage 1A - Public Hearing

**DIVISION:** Planning & Infrastructure

#### **SUMMARY:**

A public hearing is required to hear from anyone who may be affected by Bylaw C-1191-22.

Bylaw C-1191-22, a Land Use Bylaw amendment redistricting approximately 0.61 hectares of land from P2 – Natural Areas District and UR – Urban Reserve District to P1– Parks and Recreation District, is being brought forward for consideration by Council.

Administration supports this amendment.

# **BACKGROUND / ANALYSIS:**

This bylaw proposes, for Council's consideration, a Land Use Bylaw amendment to redistrict approximately 0.61 hectares of land from P2 – Natural Areas District and UR – Urban Reserve District to P1– Parks and Recreation District required for a stormwater management facility.

Additionally, notice was mailed directly to landowners within 30m of the subject lands, and also published on the City's website.

This public hearing fulfills the statutory requirement under the *Municipal Government Act* to hear from those affected by this proposed bylaw. Following the statutory public hearing, second and third reading will be brought forward for consideration by Council.
