
- From:

Land Use Concept

- >> This site is at the interface of Park / Open Space and Stormwater Management Facility land use areas.
- The current interface boundary was determined using biophysical, hydrogeological, and geo-technical study of the existing wetland complex.
- >> The ASP's Land Use Concept is at a large scale, and the proposal is 'consistent' with the ASP.





Stormwater Management Facility Expansion






- Detailed engineering design indicates that 0.61 ha of additional land is required for stormwater management.
- This expansion area is highlighted in yellow and extends:
 - 15m west,
 - 30m north, and
 - 10m east.





Natural Area Considerations





- Requires additional encroachment into area wetlands.
- This is supported by an updated Wetland Assessment and Impact Report.
- Alberta Environment and Parks has conditionally approved this additional wetland encroachment.
