NOISE CONTROL BYLAW

A Bylaw of the City of Spruce Grove in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of prohibiting, eliminating and abating noise.

WHEREAS, the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA, 2000, c. M-26, provides that the Council of a <u>Municipality municipality</u> may pass a <u>Bylawbylaw</u> for the purpose of prohibiting, eliminating or abating noise; in all or a designated part or location of a municipality, and

WHEREAS the *Traffic Safety Act*, RSA, 2000 c. T-6 provides that the Council of a <u>Municipality municipality</u> may make <u>Bylawsbylaws</u> defining what constitutes objectionable <u>Noisenoise</u>, devising a system or method of determining or measuring that <u>Noisenoise</u>, and prohibiting the operation of a <u>Motor Vehiclemotor vehicle</u> which in any manner makes objectionable <u>Noisesnoises</u>;

NOW THEREFORE, The Municipal Council of the City of Spruce _Grove duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. Section 1 SHORT TITLE

1.1. This Bylaw may be cited as "the Noise Control Bylaw"

2. Section 2 DEFINITIONS

- 2.1. "City" means the municipal corporation of the City of Spruce Grove
- 2.2. "City Manager" means the City Manager for the City of Spruce Grove or a designated officer appointed by Council.
- 2.3. Community Event" means any celebration, event, activity or thing so designated by Resolution of Council, and to which this Bylawbylaw shall not apply by reason of said designation.
- 2.4 "Community Recreation" means recreational, social or multipurpose use in a venue without fixed seats and with an occupancy capacity of less -than
- 2.4. _500 —persons, —primarily —intended —for —local community purposes. Typical uses include community -halls, community centers, -and community league buildings operated by local -community organizations.
- 2.5. 2.5 "Construction Equipment" includes but is not limited to a riveting machine, concrete mixer, gravel crusher, steam shovel, dragline, backhoe, air or steam compressor, jack-hammer, pneumatic drill, tractor other than a tractor used in a Farming Operation operation, bulldozer, front end loader, motor scraper, motor grader or any other tool, device –or- machine –of a- noisy nature.
- 2.6. Construction Noise" means Noise noise caused by Construction Equipment construction equipment

- 2.7. Council" means the Municipal Council of the City of Spruce Grove.
- 2.8 "Holiday" means any day declared as such by Municipal, Provincial or Federal authority and includes Sundays.
- 2.9 "Lease" means a lease to use the property for a period of time in excess of 48 hours.
- <u>1.1.</u> <u>2.10</u> <u>"Excessive "License" means a license to use the property for a period of time in excess of 72 hours.</u>

- 1.1. 2.11 "Motor Vehicle" means Motor Vehicle as defined in the *Traffic Safety Act*, RSA, 2000, c. T-6
- 2.8. 2.12 "Noise" means any sound which in the opinion of the Peace Officer, having regard for all circumstances, including the time of day and the nature of the activity generating the sound, is likely to unreasonably annoy or disturb persons or to injure, endanger or detract from the comfort, repose, health, peace or safety of persons within the boundary of the City of Spruce Grove.
- 2.9. "Holiday" means any day declared as such by municipal, provincial or federal government and includes Sundays.
- 2.10. "Lease" means a lease to use the property for a period of time in excess of 48 hours.
- 2.11. "License" means a license to use the property for a period of time in excess of 72 hours.
- 2.12. "Motor Vehicle" means motor vehicle as defined in the *Traffic Safety Act*, RSA, 2000, c. T-6
- 2.13—"Off highway Vehicle" means an Off Highway Vehicle -as defined in the Off 2.13. Highway Vehicle Traffic Safety Act, RSA 1980, c.0-4, as amended.
- - 2.14.1 with respect to property used for <u>Community Recreation community recreation</u>, the <u>Personperson</u> with the <u>Short Term Rental Agreement</u>, <u>Sublicense Agreement</u>, <u>Lease short term rental agreement</u>, <u>sublicense agreement</u>, <u>lease</u> or <u>License license</u> to use the property, and the <u>Personperson</u> occupying or otherwise controlling the said property, but does not include the <u>Person person</u> who is the registered owner of the property.
 - b. 2.14.2 with respect to all other property, the Personperson with the Short Term Rental Agreement, Sublicense Agreement, Leaseshort term rental agreement, sublicense agreement, lease or Licenselicense to use the Propertyproperty, the Personperson occupying or otherwise controlling the said Propertyproperty and the Personperson who is the registered owner of the Propertyproperty.
- <u>2.15.</u> "Peace Officer" means a member of the Royal -Canadian Mounted Police, and a Peace Officer appointed under the Peace Officer Act, or a City of Spruce Grove Enforcement Services Bylaw Officer.
- 2.16. Permit" means a written permit issued by the City Manager pursuant to Section 4.1 of the Bylawbylaw.
- 2.17 "Person" includes anany individual, corporation, firm, partnership, corporation, trustee, executor or administratorassociation, society, or registered company.
- 2.18. 2.18 "Short Term Rental Agreement" means a right to use –property for a period of time of 72 hours or less.

- 2.19. 2.19 "Sublicense Agreement" means a right to use property for a period of 72 hours or less, which is obtained from the holder of a <u>Licenselicense</u> to use the said property.
- 2.20—"Violation Tag" means a ticket or similar document issued by a Peace
 2.20. Officer pursuant to the *Municipal -Government Act*, RSA, 2000, c. M-26.
- 2.21—"Violation Ticket" means a ticket issued pursuant to Part II of the 2.21. Provincial Offences Procedure Act, RSA, 2000, c. P-34.


Section 3 Violations

3. 3.1 VIOLATIONS

- 3.1. Except to the extent permitted by the Bylawbylaw, no person shall:
 - a. 3.1.1—cause excessive noise within the City—;
 - <u>b.</u> <u>3.1.2</u> operate or permit any other <u>Personperson</u> to operate within the City a <u>Motor Vehicle motor vehicle</u> that causes <u>Noise.excessive noise; or</u>

- 3.2. No owner shall allow property they own to be used in such a way that there is excessive noise originating from the property.
- 3.3 A Peace Officer may direct any Personperson who has caused or made Noiseexcessive noise, or any Personperson who owns property from which Noiseexcessive noise has originated, to abate or eliminate the Noiseexcessive noise. Such a direction may be either verbal or written. If the direction is written, the direction –shall –be –in –the –form –set –out –in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this Bylawbylaw.
- 3.4. Where an activity which is not specifically prohibited by any federal, provincial or municipal laws or regulations, including this Bylawbylaw and which involves creating or making a sound which:
 - a. 3.4.1 is or may become; or
 - b. 3.4.2 creates or produces or may create or produce Noise,
 - <u>noise</u>, a— person engaging in such activity shall do so in such manner as to create as little sound as practicable under the circumstances.
- 3.5. 3.5 Engine Retarder Brakes
 - a. 3.5.1—The use of Engine Retarder Brakes is prohibited within the City Limits. Such limits shall include that portion of Highway 16A, which passes through the City of Spruce Grove.

4. Section 4 PERMITS AND NON-APPLICATION OF BYLAW

- 4.1. The City Manager may upon written request; issue a –permit -to a Personperson for the purpose of suspending the provisions of this By-Lawbylaw, and the Permitpermit shall specify the dates and hours during which Noise noise may occur.
- 4.2. Any such Permitpermit issued shall be produced to a Peace Officer upon demand.
- 4.3. Persons owning or controlling Construction Equipment construction equipment, and Personspersons owning or controlling land on which Construction Equipment construction equipment is being operated shall be exempt from the provisions of this By-Lawbylaw if:
 - <u>a.</u> <u>4.3.1</u> the <u>Noisenoise</u> is generated pursuant to work done in the normal manner to the industry;

- b. 4.3.2 the Noise is generated between the hours as authorized by and set out in Schedule "B" attached to and forming part of this Bylawbylaw; and
- c. 4.3.3—all necessary federal, provincial and municipal permits, licenses and approvals have been –obtained and the work is not contrary to any federal, provincial or municipal laws or regulations.
- 4.4. This Bylawbylaw does not apply:
 - a. 4.4.1 to work carried on by the City of Spruce Grove or its agents, contractors, servants or employees, acting within the scope of the agency, contract, or employment, as the case may be.

- 4.4.2 to the performance of work by any person on land zoned as M-1

 b. Industrial pursuant to the City of Spruce Grove Land Use Bylaw, as amended, if:
 - (i) 4.4.2.1—the Noisenoise is generated pursuant to the work done in the normal manner to that end; and
 - c. 4.4.3 to Personspersons operating domestic equipment including, without restricting the generality of the foregoing, lawn mowers, snow blowers, garden tillers, hedge trimmers, weed trimmers and air blowers, gas or electric, and persons owning or controlling property upon which such Equipment is used if the Noisenoise is of a temporary or intermittent nature, the equipment is properly maintained and operated in a normal manner for that type of equipment; and the Noisenoise occurs between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.; or
 - d. 4.4.4 to Community Events.

5. Section 5 AUTHORIZATION TO INSPECT

5.1. A Peace Officer may enter any land, building or premise to inspect for conditions that may constitute a contravention of this Bylawbylaw.

6. Section 6 EMERGENCIES

6.1. Nothing shall render any <u>Personperson</u> liable to a fine, penalty or punishment for performing work of an emergency nature for the preservation or protection of life, health or property.

7. Section 7 PENALTIES

- 7.1. Any Personperson who contravenes the provisions of this Bylawbylaw is guilty of —an offence and liable upon summary conviction;
 - 7.1.1 to a fine for a first offence as set out in Schedule "C" attached hereto and forming part of this Bylawbylaw;
 - <u>b.</u> 7.1.2 to a fine for a second offence as set out in Schedule "C" attached hereto and forming part of this <u>By-Lawbylaw</u>.
- 7.2. 7.1.3 under Under no –circumstances –shall –any –Person person contravening any provisions of this Bylawbylaw be subject to the penalty of imprisonment.

8. Section 8 VIOLATION TagTAG

8.1 A Peace Officer is hereby authorized and empowered to issue a Violation Tag-violation tag to any person who the Peace officer has reasonable and probable grounds to believe has contravened any provisions of this By-Lawbylaw.

- 8.2 Any Personperson who is issued a Violation Tagviolation tag for contravention of this By-Lawbylaw shall immediately discontinue creating excessive noise to avoid prosecution or a second offence.
- 8.3. If the Noiseexcessive noise continues, or is allowed to continue, a second Violation tag may be issued.

8.4. Where a Violation Tagviolation tag is issued pursuant to this ByLawbylaw, the Personperson whom the Violation Tagviolation tag is issued may, in
lieu of being prosecuted –for the offence, pay the City of Spruce Grove—the
penalty specified on –the Violation Tagviolation tag.

9. Section 9 VIOLATION TICKET

- 9.2. Notwithstanding Section 8.1 of this By-Lawbylaw a Peace Officer is hereby authorized and empowered to immediately issue a Violation Ticketviolation ticket pursuant to Part II of the Provincial Offences Procedures Act, RSA. 2000 c. P-34, as amended to any person who the Peace Officer has reasonable grounds to believe has contravened any provisions of this Bylawbylaw.

10. Section 10 SEVERABILITY

10.1. If at any time, any provision of this Bylawbylaw is declared or held to be illegal, invalid, or ultra vires, in whole or in part, then the provision shall not apply and the remainder of this Bylawbylaw shall continue in full force and effect and be construed as if it had been enacted without the illegal, invalid or ultra vires provision.

11. Bylaw 644-82 is rescinded when Bylaw C-475-03 comes EFFECTIVE DATE

This bylaw shall come into full effect.

11.1. This Bylaw comes into full force and effect upon being given being given Thirdthird and Final reading.

12.1. Bylaw C-475-03 is hereby repealed.
